55th International Film Festival of India (IFFI) from 20 to 28

November 2024 in Goa
22/11/2024


The 55th International Film Festival of India (IFFI) kicked off with a starstudded opening ceremony at the Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Indoor Stadium in Panaji, Goa, on November 20, 2024. Goa Chief Minister Pramod Sawant, Information and Broadcasting Secretary Sanjay Jaju, and festival director Shekhar Kapur were among the dignitaries present.

The festival, which runs from November 20 to November 28, 2024, will showcase over 180 international titles from 81 countries, including 16 world premieres, 3 international premieres, 43 Asian premieres, and 109 Indian films. This year, the festival has a special segment dedicated to Goan films, with 14 films being screened.

One of the highlights of the festival is the world premiere of Prime Video's first-ever celebrity chat show, "The Rana Daggubati Show," which will feature a dazzling line-up of guests, including Nani, Dulquer Salmaan, and S.S. Rajamouli. The festival will also host the Asia premiere of the internationally

acclaimed movie "The Mehta Boys," directed by Boman Irani].

The 55th IFFI aims to celebrate global cinema and connect filmmakers with cinephiles to explore the art of filmmaking.



Guru Nanak Jayanti or Gurpurab on 15 November 2024 15/11/2024

Guru Nanak Jayanti, also known as Gurpurab, is one of the most sacred festivals in Sikhism. It commemorates the birth of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the founder of Sikhism and the first of the ten Sikh Gurus. Observed on the full moon day in the month of Kartik (October-November), it holds immense religious and cultural significance for Sikhs and is celebrated with great devotion around the world. This year Guru Nanak Jayanti celebrated on 15 November 2024.

Significance

Guru Nanak Dev Ji was born in 1469 in Talwandi, now known as Nankana Sahib in Pakistan. He is revered as a spiritual leader who taught principles of equality, compassion, and devotion to God. His teachings emphasized love, selflessness, and unity. Guru Nanak's message, captured in the sacred text Guru Granth Sahib, promotes "Naam Japna" (meditation on God's name), "Kirat Karni" (honest

work), and "Vand Chakna" (sharing with others).



Indian musicians Ricky Kej and Anoushka Shankar nominated for the 67th Grammy Awards 11/11/2024

Indian musicians Ricky Kej and Anoushka Shankar have received Grammy nominations for the 67th Grammy Awards. Ricky Kej, a three-time Grammy winner, earned his fourth nomination for his album *Break of Dawn* in the Best New Age, Ambient, or Chant Album category.

Anoushka Shankar was nominated in the same category for her album Chapter II: How Dark It Is Before Dawn, showcasing her blend of traditional and modern music.

Other nominees in this category include *Warriors of Light* by Radhika Vekaria and *Triveni* by Chandrika Tandon, featuring flautist Wouter Kellerman and cellist Eru Matsumoto.

The Grammy Awards will be held on February 2, 2025, at the Crypto.com Arena in Los Angeles.



<u>Four-day Chhath Puja festival</u> <u>began on November 5, 2024</u> 06/11/2024

The four-day Chhath Puja festival began on November 5, 2024, with the ritual of Nahay-Khay. Devotees started the festival by taking holy dips in rivers and performing puja to the Sun God, consuming offerings like Arwa rice and Chana dal. In Bihar, large gatherings formed along the Ganga, Kosi, Gandak, and other rivers.

On November 6, the Kharna ritual will be observed, followed by a strict 36-hour fast without water. The First Arghya, offerings to the setting Sun, will be given on November 7, and the festival will conclude on November 8 with a final Arghya to the rising Sun. Devotees will gather at riverbanks and famous Sun temples across Bihar. Chief Minister Nitish Kumar extended greetings for Chhath Puja.



'Sunflowers Were The First Ones To Know' qualifies for 2025 Oscars Short Film category 05/11/2024

The Film and Television Institute of India (FTII) student film Sunflowers Were The First Ones To Know has qualified for the 2025 Oscars in the Live Action Short Film category. Directed by FTII student Chidananda S Naik, this Kannada short film is inspired by Indian folk stories and traditions. Earlier, it won first prize at the Cannes Film Festival's La Cinef Selection, where the jury praised its storytelling and direction.

The film follows the story of an elderly woman who steals the village rooster, causing sunlight to disappear and bringing chaos to the community. A prophecy then forces her family into exile to retrieve the rooster and restore peace.

Sunflowers will have special screenings and events to connect with global audiences, showcasing India's storytelling traditions and universal themes that resonate worldwide.



Ningol Chakkouba festival celebrated in Manipur 04/11/2024

The Ningol Chakkouba festival, one of Manipur's biggest, was celebrated on November 3, 2024. It is a special festival for the Meitei community but is

now enjoyed by other communities too.

Ningol Chakkouba happens each year on the second day of the Meitei lunar month called Hiyangei. On this day, married sisters come to their maternal homes for a big feast and happy reunion, where gifts are exchanged. Traditionally, the brother invites his sister a week before the festival. Many Manipuris celebrate this festival even when they are living outside Manipur.

Nobel Prize 2024 in Economics awarded to to Daron Acemoglu, Simon Johnson, and James A. Robinson 18/10/2024

On October 14, 2024, the Sveriges Riksbank Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel was awarded to Daron Acemoglu, Simon Johnson, and James A. Robinson for their research on how institutions are formed and their impact on a nation's prosperity. Their work demonstrates that societal institutions, especially those introduced during European colonization, play a crucial role in determining a country's long-term economic success or stagnation.

Financial news subscriptions

They found that inclusive institutions, which benefit society as a whole, promote growth, while extractive institutions, which exploit the population for the benefit of those in power, hinder development. The laureates' research also explains why reforms are often difficult to implement in countries with extractive institutions and why, in some cases, democratization occurs as a solution to this problem. Their work sheds light on the challenge of reducing global income disparities by emphasizing the critical role of institutions.

The fair is divided into two parts:


Business Days: November 14-18, exclusively for business visitors.

Cyclonic Storm Fengal Makes Landfall Between Karaikal and Mahabalipuram

30/11/2024

Cyclonic storm Fengal, made landfall between Karaikal and Mahabalipuram near Puducherry on 30 November 2024, bring heavy rainfall and strong winds gusting up to 90 km/h. The Puducherry administration and Tamil Nadu authorities are on high alert, implementing extensive disaster management measures.

Emergency Preparations: The Disaster Management Emergency Operations

Center is monitoring the situation.
Officials, including District Collector A.
Kulothungan, inspected low-lying
areas and issued instructions to
address challenges swiftly. NDRF
trained personnel on portable lighting
systems for power outages, while
awareness campaigns urge residents
to avoid unnecessary travel.



CoP29 UN Climate Change
Conference, held in Baku,
Azerbaijan, from November 11
to 22, 2024

24/11/2024

The 29th session of the Conference of the Parties (CoP29) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) was held in Baku, Azerbaijan, from November 11 to November 22, 2024. This significant global event brought together world leaders, negotiators, business leaders, young people, climate scientists, Indigenous Peoples, and civil society to discuss and advance collective climate action.

One of the key priorities of CoP29 was to secure a new goal on climate finance. The conference aimed to ensure that every country has the means to take stronger climate action, slash greenhouse gas emissions, and build resilient communities. A notable outcome was the agreement to triple public finance to developing countries, increasing it from USD 100 billion annually to USD 300 billion annually by 2035.

Despite the progress made, the conference faced challenges, including tense disagreements over climate finance and walkouts by some parties. The final deal was criticized for not fully addressing the scale, urgency, and inequity of the climate

emergency. However, the conference laid the groundwork for future negotiations and highlighted the importance of continued global cooperation to tackle climate change.



GRAP Stage-4 implemented in Delhi-NCR from Nov 18 as Air Quality turns 'Severe'

18/11/2024

Due to severe air quality in Delhi-NCR, GRAP Stage-4 restrictions were implemented from 8 AM on November 18, 2024. The entry of heavy vehicles from other states is banned, except for trucks carrying essential commodities or services, and CNG, electric, and BS-VI diesel trucks.

The decision was made during a meeting of the Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM). The Air Quality Index (AQI) in Delhi reached 452 by 6 PM, with most areas recording AQI levels above 450, as per the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).

National Milk Day (26
November): Honoring Dr.
Verghese Kurien, the Father of
the White Revolution in India
27/11/2024

National Milk Day was celebrated on 26 November 2024 to honor the 103rd birth anniversary of Dr.

Verghese Kurien, known as the Father of the White Revolution in India. This day highlights the remarkable growth in milk production, especially in Gujarat, the heart of India's White Revolution.

Over the past 22 years, Gujarat's milk production has increased by 119.63 lakh metric tons, with an average growth rate of 10.23%—outpacing the national growth rate. The state now contributes 7.49% of India's total milk production. There has also been an unprecedented rise in the per capita availability of milk in Gujarat during this period.

The Amul Federation, which started with 6 member unions and a turnover of Rs. 49 crore, now includes 18 member unions. It collects over 3 crore liters of milk daily, producing and distributing dairy products not only

across India but also in about **50 countries**. The **Amul model** has become a globally recognized example of a self-reliant dairy development model, benefiting livestock farmers' socio-economic growth.



75th Anniversary of the Adoption of the Indian Constitution:
Campaign Tagline 'Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Swabhimaan'

26/11/2024

The Government of India has announced year-long celebrations, beginning November 26, 2024, to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the adoption of the Indian Constitution. These celebrations, under the campaign tagline "Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Swabhimaan" (Our Constitution, Our Pride), will run until November 26, 2025, honoring the Constitution adopted on November 26, 1949, which came into effect on January 26, 1950.

A grand event will be held at the Central Hall of Samvidhan Sadan, where President Droupadi Murmu will address both Houses of Parliament. Activities will be organized nationwide, including at village and district levels, focusing on the core values of the Constitution and the contributions of its makers. Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju emphasized the celebration as a collective national effort, while

Law and Justice Minister Arjun Ram Meghwal highlighted Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's significant role and the contributions of 15 women in the Drafting Committee.



Janjatiya Gaurav Divas, Birth Anniversary of Birsa Munda 16/11/2024

Janjatiya Gaurav Divas, also known as Tribal Pride Day, is celebrated annually on November 15th in India. This day was officially designated in 2021 to honor the contributions and sacrifices of India's tribal communities, especially their role in the country's freedom struggle.



National Education Day is celebrated in India on November 11 each year to emphasize the importance of education and recognize efforts toward making quality education accessible to all. This day honors the legacy of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, India's first Education Minister, born on November 18, 1888, and posthumously awarded the Bharat Ratna in 1992 for his significant contributions to the nation.

Azad was a freedom fighter, scholar, and visionary who laid the foundation for India's modern education system. He was instrumental in establishing key institutions, including the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the University Grants Commission (UGC), and India's first Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) in Kharagpur, supporting advancements in higher and technical education.

Under his leadership, various cultural and educational institutions, such as the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Sahitya Akademi, Lalit Kala Akademi, and Sangeet Natak Akademi, were founded to promote Indian culture and research. Azad's vision extended to inclusive education, focusing on universal primary education, adult literacy, and education for the rural poor, particularly girls.

Azad saw education as a fundamental right and a vehicle for social progress, advocating for it as a tool for national empowerment. His contributions continue to influence India's education policy, emphasizing inclusivity and progress.



National Cancer Awareness Day: November 7

08/11/2024

National Cancer Awareness Day is observed annually on November 7, aiming to raise awareness about cancer prevention, early detection, and treatment. Established in 2014, this day highlights the importance of public education on cancer and emphasizes early intervention to improve survival rates.

It coincides with the birth anniversary of Marie Curie, whose discoveries of radium and polonium have significantly contributed to cancer treatment. On this day, free screenings are offered at municipal clinics, government hospitals, and CGHS facilities to encourage early detection.

Masato Kanda elected as President of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) 29/11/2024

Masato Kanda has been unanimously elected as the 11th President of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) by its Board of Governors. Currently serving as Special Advisor to Japan's Prime Minister and Minister of Finance, Kanda will assume office in February 2025, succeeding Masatsugu Asakawa. His term will conclude on 23 November 2026.

ADB, founded in 1966 and headquartered in Manila, Philippines, focuses on social and economic development in Asia. It started with 31 members and now has 68, including members of the UN Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific and non-regional developed countries.



Ceasefire deal between Israel and Hezbollah

27/11/2024

The Israeli government has approved a US- and France-brokered ceasefire deal with Hezbollah in Lebanon, as announced by Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's office on 26 November 2024.

The ceasefire aims to end the year-long conflict that has killed 3,800 people and injured 16,000 in Lebanon. Under the agreement, both Israeli forces and Hezbollah will withdraw from south Lebanon within 60 days, with Hezbollah repositioning north of the Litani River. The Lebanese national army and UN peacekeeping forces will secure the vacated areas.

While Lebanon's foreign minister supports the agreement, Netanyahu highlighted Israel's "full freedom of military action" and warned of immediate responses to violations. He also cited three strategic reasons for the ceasefire:

Countering Iranian threats,

Resupplying Israeli forces amid delays in advanced weaponry deliveries, and

Isolating Hamas by preventing a multifront conflict.

The deal has received international backing, with French President Emmanuel Macron and US President Joe Biden committing to its enforcement.



Yamandú Orsi wins Presidential Election in Uruguay 26/11/2024

Yamandú Orsi of the Broad Front alliance has emerged victorious as Uruguay's next president. Orsi, a former history teacher and mayor,

secured **49.8% of the votes** in a closely contested run-off election held on **November 24, 2024**. He defeated **Álvaro Delgado** of the center-right National Party, who garnered **45.9% support**.

Orsi's victory marks the return of a center-left government to Uruguay after five years of conservative administration. He is considered the political heir of former President José Mujica, who supported him throughout his campaign. Orsi has pledged to promote a "modern left" approach, focusing on tackling homelessness, poverty, and crime.



Russia has launched an Inter-Continental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) targeting Ukraine 22/11/2024

In a significant escalation of the ongoing conflict, Russia has launched an Inter-Continental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) targeting Ukraine on 21 November 2024. This marks the first time such a weapon has been used in the conflict, highlighting the increasing intensity of the situation.

The missile was launched from the Astrakhan region in Russia and targeted the city of Dnipro in centraleastern Ukraine. The attack also involved the launch of six Kh-101 cruise missiles, five of which were intercepted by Ukrainian air defenses. The use of an ICBM, which typically has a range

exceeding 5,500 kilometers and can carry nuclear or conventional warheads, represents a major escalation in the conflict.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky condemned the attack, stating that it demonstrates Russia's use of Ukraine as a testing ground for its advanced weaponry. The European Union has also expressed concern, calling the attack a "clear escalation" and a significant change in the nature of the conflict.

This development follows recent updates to Russia's nuclear doctrine, which now considers aggression from a non-nuclear state supported by a nuclear power as a direct threat to its sovereignty. The situation remains tense, with international observers closely monitoring the developments.



<u>19th G20 Summit Concludes;</u> <u>Next Summit in 2025 in South</u> <u>Africa</u>

20/11/2024

The 19th G20 Summit concluded on 19 November 2024, with Brazil's President Lula Da Silva handing over the presidency to South Africa's President Cyril Ramaphosa. President Lula highlighted key initiatives during Brazil's presidency, including:

Launching the **Global Alliance Against Hunger and Poverty**.

Introducing a debate on taxing and integrating **climate change** into the agendas of Finance Ministries and Central Banks.

Approving the first multilateral document on the **bioeconomy**.

Establishing a Women's Empowerment Working Group and proposing a new Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) to promote racial equality.

Committing to triple global renewable energy capacity by 2030 and forming a coalition for local production of vaccines and medicines.

Advocating reforms to make **global governance more representative** and engaging society through the **G20 Social** platform.

The summit also focused on addressing health challenges through WHO investment rounds, fostering cooperation in open innovation, and creating a task force for the governance of artificial intelligence.

President Lula noted that South Africa's presidency would mark the completion of a leadership cycle in which all G20 member countries will have led the group at least once. The event represented the penultimate stage of a four-year sequence of G20 leadership by developing countries: Indonesia, India, Brazil, and South Africa.



19th G20 Summit, leaders adopt Rio de Janeiro Declaration 19/11/2024

At the 19th G20 Summit in Rio de Janeiro, leaders adopted the **Rio de Janeiro Declaration** on November 18, 2024. The declaration emphasized addressing global challenges such as **climate change**, conflicts in Ukraine and West Asia, and promoting **sustainable and inclusive growth**. Key highlights include:

UN Security Council Reforms: A call to expand its composition to improve representation of underrepresented regions and groups.

Condemnation of Terrorism: Firm opposition to all forms of terrorism.

Humanitarian Concerns: Urged increased humanitarian aid and civilian protection in the **Gaza Strip** and **Lebanon**.

Conflict Resolution: Advocated for peaceful resolutions and diplomatic solutions to crises.

Climate Commitments: Reaffirmed dedication to multilateralism, progress under the UNFCCC, and the Paris Agreement.

The declaration highlights the G20's role in fostering global cooperation and addressing pressing crises.



Sri Lanka's ruling National
People's Power (NPP) party,
secured a landslide victory in
Parliamentary Elections
16/11/2024

Sri Lanka's ruling **National People's Power (NPP)** party, led by
President **Anura Kumara Dissanayake**,
secured a landslide victory in the
parliamentary elections, winning **159 out of 225 seats** (approximately 63% of
the votes). This marks a dramatic shift
in Sri Lankan politics, as the NPP
previously held only three seats.

The main opposition **Samagi Jana Balawegaya**, led by Sajith Premadasa, won 40 seats, while **Ilankai Tamil Arasu Kadchi** secured 8 seats. The **New Democratic Front**, aligned with former President Ranil Wickremasinghe, faced a major setback with only 5 seats.

This victory, following the 2022 economic crisis and the ousting of Gotabaya Rajapaksa, is seen as a strong mandate for President Dissanayake's promises to combat corruption, recover stolen assets, and implement reforms to address poverty and economic challenges. The NPP's leftist coalition has gained significant support, including from minority communities.



PM Modi is on a six-day visit to Nigeria, Brazil, and Guyana from November 16 to 21, 2024 16/11/2024

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is on a six-day visit to Nigeria, Brazil, and Guyana from November 16 to 21, 2024, strengthening India's bilateral and multilateral relations.

Nigeria (Nov 16-17):

PM Modi's visit marks the first by an Indian Prime Minister in 17 years. He will hold talks with Nigerian leadership to review the strategic partnership, focusing on economic, energy, and defense collaboration. India and Nigeria have been strategic partners since 2007, with over 200 Indian companies investing \$27 billion in Nigeria. He will also engage with the Indian diaspora in Nigeria.

Brazil (Nov 18):

PM Modi will attend the G20 Summit in Rio de Janeiro, hosted by Brazilian President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva. As part of the G20 Troika with Brazil and South Africa, he will discuss global issues, build on India's leadership in the G20, and hold bilateral meetings with world leaders.

Guyana (Nov 19-21):

PM Modi's visit is the first by an Indian Prime Minister since 1968. He will meet Guyana's President Dr. Mohamed Irfaan Ali, address the Guyanese
Parliament, and interact with the
Indian diaspora. He will also
participate in the Second CARICOMIndia Summit in Georgetown to
deepen ties with the 15-member
Caribbean Community (CARICOM),
focusing on economic integration and
cooperation.



Inauguration of first trilateral power transaction between Nepal, India, and Bangladesh 16/11/2024

The first trilateral power transaction between Nepal, India, and Bangladesh was inaugurated on November 15, 2024, via the Indian power grid. The event was virtually inaugurated by India's Power Minister Manohar Lal, Bangladesh's Power Adviser Fouzul Kabir Khan, and Nepal's Energy Minister Dipak Khadka. This historic power flow of up to 40 MW from Nepal to Bangladesh marks a significant milestone in sub-regional energy cooperation.

The initiative, initially announced during Nepal PM Pushpa Kamal Dahal's visit to India last year, highlights a commitment to enhancing sub-regional connectivity and mutual economic benefits. The foundation was laid with a tripartite agreement between NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam, Nepal Electricity Authority, and

Bangladesh Power Development Board, signed on October 3, 2024. This collaboration is expected to strengthen power sector interlinkages in the region.



Dr. Navin Ramgoolam return as Prime Minister in Mauritius 12/11/2024

On November 11, 2024, Dr. Navin Ramgoolam secured a historic electoral victory in Mauritius, marking his return as the Prime Minister for the third time. This victory came after the incumbent Prime Minister Pravind Jugnauth conceded defeat in the parliamentary elections held on November 10, 2024.

Dr. Ramgoolam, who previously served as Prime Minister from 1995 to 2000 and from 2005 to 2014, is the son of Mauritius' first Prime Minister, **Seewoosagur Ramgoolam**. His win is seen as a significant shift in the political landscape of Mauritius, with his party, the **Alliance of Change**, gaining a majority in the parliament.



29th annual UN COP29 in Baku, Azerbaijan from 11 to 22 November

11/11/2024

The 29th UN Climate Change Conference, or COP29, began in Baku, Azerbaijan, on November 11, 2024. This year, known as the "Finance COP," the main focus is on setting a new financial target to help countries most affected by climate change. Over two weeks, delegates from almost 200 countries, including India, will work to advance the Paris Agreement goals—limiting global warming, boosting climate resilience, and supporting developing nations.

The success of COP29 will depend largely on whether countries can agree on a strong new climate finance goal that meets the needs of developing countries. For India and other Global South countries, access to finance, technology, and energy resources is crucial for achieving climate goals and protecting vulnerable communities. India has been active in shaping the global climate finance system to ensure funding is available for both reducing emissions and adapting to climate impacts.



Donald Trump won the U.S. presidential election 07/11/2024

On November 6, 2024, Donald Trump won the U.S. presidential election, securing 277 electoral votes, surpassing the required 270 and defeating Democrat Kamala Harris. His victory, clinched with a key win in Wisconsin and other swing states like Pennsylvania, Georgia, and North Carolina, sparked celebrations among Republicans as Trump became the 47th U.S. President.

In his victory speech from Palm Beach, Florida, Trump pledged to focus on ending global conflicts, emphasizing a commitment to "stop wars, not start them." He also reiterated his immigration policy stance, advocating for stricter border control and legal immigration pathways, and expressed gratitude to his supporters, including immigrant communities. His running mate, JD Vance, praised Trump's win as a historic political comeback.

World leaders, including Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy, French President Emmanuel Macron, and Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan, congratulated Trump on his win through social media platform X. Italian President Giorgia Meloni and NATO Secretary General Mark Rutte also extended congratulations.

UGC Introduces Accelerated and Extended Degree Programmes for UG Students 30/11/2024

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has approved Standard Operating Procedures for introducing Accelerated Degree **Programmes** and **Extended Degree Programmes** for undergraduate students. The Accelerated Degree Programme allows students to complete three-year or four-year degrees in a shorter time by earning additional credits per semester. In contrast, the Extended Degree Programme provides flexibility to extend degree completion by up to two semesters with reduced credits per semester.

Students will still earn the same total credits as in the standard-duration programmes, ensuring their degrees are treated equally for employment and academic purposes. Higher Education Institutions will evaluate eligibility through dedicated committees and may allocate up to 10% of sanctioned seats for the Accelerated Programme. Degrees will be awarded based on the opted

timeline rather than the standard duration.



India's Mineral Production Shows Strong Growth in FY 2024-25 29/11/2024

India's mineral production showed strong growth in the first half of FY 2024-25 (April-October), continuing momentum from record levels in FY 2023-24.

Iron Ore: Accounting for 69% of total mineral production by value, iron ore output rose by 4.1% to 158.4 million metric tonnes (MMT) in April-October 2024, compared to 152.1 MMT in the same period last year.

Manganese Ore: Production increased by 11.1% to 2.0 MMT.

Bauxite: Output grew by 11.3%, reaching 13.8 MMT.

Primary Aluminium: Production rose modestly by 1.2% to 24.46 lakh tonnes (LT).

Refined Copper: Output saw significant growth of 6%, climbing to 3.00 LT.

India remains a key player globally, ranking as the second-largest Aluminium producer, among the top ten in refined copper, and the fourth-largest iron ore producer. The growth

reflects strong domestic demand from sectors such as steel, energy, infrastructure, and automotive, reinforcing India's economic resilience and its role in the global minerals supply chain.



India climbs 11 places in the
Network Readiness Index 2024
(NRI 2024), securing the 49th
rank globally

28/11/2024

India has climbed 11 places in the Network Readiness Index 2024 (NRI 2024), securing the 49th rank globally, as announced on 27 November 2024. Published by the Portulans Institute, the index evaluates 133 economies across four pillars—technology, people, governance, and impact—using 54 variables. India's score improved significantly from 49.93 in 2023 to 53.63 in 2024.

India leads globally in several indicators:

1st place: Al scientific publications, Al talent concentration, and ICT services exports.

2nd place: FTTH/Building Internet subscriptions and mobile broadband internet traffic.

3rd place: Domestic market scale.

4th place: Annual investment in telecommunication services.

Key achievements include:

Rising teledensity from **75.2% to 84.69%** over the past decade.

Increasing internet subscribers from **25.1** crore to **94.4** crore, largely driven by the **Digital India initiative**.

Boosting global mobile broadband speed rankings from 118th to 15th, following the launch of 5G in 2022.

India is now focusing on next-gen technologies with the **Bharat 6G Vision**, aiming to solidify its leadership in telecom innovation.

The 43rd India International Trade Fair (IITF) concluded on **27 November 2024** at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. The theme for this year's fair was "Viksit Bharat at 2047". An award ceremony was held on the final day, recognizing achievements in various categories:

Partner States: Bihar and Uttar Pradesh won gold.

Focus State: Jharkhand secured gold.

Ministries and Departments: The Ministry of Mines received gold, while the Ayush Ministry earned silver.

States and UTs: Puducherry won gold, Meghalaya got silver, and Karnataka was awarded bronze.

Pradeep Singh Kharola, Managing Director of ITPO, shared that over 10 lakh visitors attended the fair. Executive Director Premjit Lal highlighted the fair's role as a global platform for traders to exchange ideas and grow their businesses. The event saw a significant response from visitors and exhibitors, showcasing diverse regional products.

India's domestic air traffic crosses 5 lakh passengers in a single day, marking aviation milestone

20/11/2024

India's aviation sector achieved a historic milestone on 17 November 2024 (Sunday), with over 505,412 domestic passengers flying in a single day, surpassing the 5 lakh mark for the first time. The Ministry of Civil Aviation celebrated the achievement, describing it as a reflection of India's growing aviation potential.

Civil Aviation Minister K. Ram Mohan Naidu credited this success to key policies such as the Regional Connectivity Scheme (UDAN), which was launched in 2017 to improve connectivity to underserved regions, advancements in airport infrastructure, and the adoption of digital technologies. The number of operational airports in India has doubled over the past decade, supporting rapid growth in the sector.



K Sanjay Murthy appointed as Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of India

20/11/2024

President Droupadi Murmu has appointed **K Sanjay Murthy**, an IAS officer of the 1989 batch (Andhra Pradesh cadre), as the new **Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of India**. Murthy, currently the Secretary of the Department of Higher Education, will assume the role once he takes charge, replacing **Girish Chandra Murmu**, who held office since August 8, 2020.

The CAG of India:

Audits all Union and State government departments, including railways, defense, India Post, and telecommunications.

Oversees over 1500 public enterprises, 400 non-commercial bodies, and other entities funded by the government.

Is empowered by **Article 148** of the Constitution and governed by the **CAG's Duties**, **Powers and Conditions Act**, **1971**.

The office is supported by the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (IA&AD), comprising around 600 managerial officers and a subordinate cadre of approximately 47,000 personnel. The CAG's mandate extends to inspecting records,

transactions, and financial documents to ensure accountability and transparency in public spending.



DRDO successfully conducted a flight trial of India's first long-range hypersonic missile
18/11/2024

On November 16, 2024, DRDO successfully conducted a flight trial of India's first long-range hypersonic missile from Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Island, Odisha. The missile, capable of carrying various payloads over distances greater than 1,500 km, represents a significant technological advancement for the Armed Forces.

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh hailed the achievement as historic, positioning India among a select group of nations with advanced hypersonic military technology. The missile's performance was tracked using multiple range systems, and data from down-range ship stations confirmed accurate terminal maneuvers and impact. The Defence Minister congratulated DRDO, the Armed Forces, and the industry on this milestone.



<u>DRDO completes Flight Tests of</u> <u>Guided Pinaka Weapon System</u> 15/11/2024

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has successfully completed the flight tests of the Guided Pinaka Weapon System as part of the Provisional Staff Qualitative Requirements (PSQR) Validation Trials. According to a statement from the Defence Ministry, these flight tests were conducted across three phases at various field firing ranges.

During the trials, PSQR parameters such as range, accuracy, consistency, and rate of fire in salvo mode for multiple target engagements were thoroughly assessed through extensive testing of rockets. A total of twelve rockets from each production agency were tested using two in-service Pinaka launchers, which had been upgraded by the launcher production agencies.



<u>Dominica to confer highest</u> <u>national award, the 'Dominica</u> <u>Award of Honour', to PM Modi</u> 15/11/2024

Dominica has announced it will confer its highest national honor, the Dominica Award of Honour, on Prime Minister Narendra Modi. This award recognizes his support for Dominica during the COVID-19 pandemic, including the donation of 70,000 doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine in February 2021, and his contributions to strengthening ties between India and Dominica in healthcare, education, information technology, and sustainable development. The award will be presented by Dominica's President Sylvanie Burton at the India-CARICOM Summit in Georgetown, Guyana, from November 19-21, 2024.

Dominica's Prime Minister Roosevelt Skerrit expressed gratitude for Modi's solidarity, particularly during the global health crisis, and acknowledged Modi's role in promoting a shared vision of resilience and progress. Prime Minister Modi accepted the award offer, emphasizing India's commitment to collaborating on global challenges like climate change and regional conflicts alongside Dominica and the Caribbean.



India in Global top 10 for Patents, Trademarks, and Industrial Designs

13/11/2024

India has entered the top 10 countries globally in Patents, Trademarks, and Industrial Designs, as per the World Intellectual Property Indicators 2024 report. The report highlights India's significant growth in intellectual property (IP) activity, showing progress in patent, trademark, and industrial design applications. India ranks sixth globally for patents, with 64,480 applications, more than half from residents.

4th in Trademarks (+6.1%) with 90% resident fillings.

6th in Patents (+15.7%), driven by 55.2% resident fillings.

10th in Industrial Designs (+36.4%), Moving up 1 spot.

The patent office granted 149.4% more patents in 2023 than the previous year, demonstrating a rapidly evolving IP ecosystem. Industrial design applications rose by 36.4%, driven by sectors like Textiles and Accessories, Tools and Machines, and Health and Cosmetics, which contributed to nearly half of all design filings.



DRDO successfully conducts maiden flight test of Long Range Land Attack Cruise Missile (LRLACM)

13/11/2024

On 12 November 2024, the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) conducted the first flight test of its Long Range Land Attack Cruise Missile (LRLACM) from the Integrated Test Range in Chandipur, Odisha, using a mobile launcher. The test met all primary mission objectives, with sub-systems performing as expected.

The missile's performance was monitored by multiple range sensors, including radar, optical tracking, and telemetry systems. Equipped with advanced avionics and software, the LRLACM was developed by DRDO's Aeronautical Development Establishment in Bengaluru, with support from other labs and Indian industries.



Justice Sanjiv Khanna sworn in as the 51st Chief Justice of India (CJI)

13/11/2024

Justice Sanjiv Khanna was sworn in as the 51st Chief Justice of India (CJI) on November 11, 2024, in a ceremony at Rashtrapati Bhavan, where President Droupadi Murmu administered the oath. Key dignitaries, including Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, and other Union Cabinet members, attended the event. Justice Khanna, who joined the Supreme Court in 2019, has contributed to significant rulings, such as upholding the abrogation of Article 370 and overturning the electoral bonds scheme.

Beginning his career in 1983 under the Delhi Bar Council, Justice Khanna has expertise in constitutional law, taxation, arbitration, and environmental law. His judicial experience includes appointments at the Delhi High Court and the Supreme Court, where he handled influential cases.

The ceremony highlighted respect for judicial continuity, with retired Chief Justices and legal figures in attendance. Justice Khanna succeeds former CJI DY Chandrachud, who reflected on his tenure in a heartfelt farewell. Justice Khanna will serve a six-month term, focusing on key

national issues, as outlined by the government's recent appointment notification under Article 124 of the Indian Constitution.



3rd India-Australia joint military exercise 'AUSTRAHIND' from 8 to 21 November in Maharashtra 11/11/2024

The third edition of the India-Australia joint military exercise, AUSTRAHIND, began on November 8 at the Foreign Training Node in Pune and will continue until November 21. This exercise aims to strengthen defense cooperation and interoperability between the Indian and Australian armed forces. Started in 2022 in Rajasthan, AUSTRAHIND has become an annual event, alternating between both countries.

This year, the focus is on enhancing joint capabilities for sub-conventional operations in semi-urban and semi-desert environments under a UN mandate. The exercise includes 140 Indian personnel, mainly from the DOGRA Regiment, and 120 Australian soldiers from the 13th Light Horse Regiment. It will be conducted in two phases: combat conditioning/tactical training and a validation phase, featuring counter-terrorism tactics, joint operations, search and destroy missions, and heli-borne operations.

India and Australia's defense ties also include other exercises like AUSINDEX

(maritime) and PITCHBLACK (air force) and regular policy dialogues. The start of AUSTRAHIND follows External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar's recent visit to Australia, further strengthening their diplomatic and strategic relationship.



New Centralised Pension Payments System (CPPS) completes pilot run 09/11/2024

On November 8, 2024, Union Minister of Labour and Employment Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya announced the successful pilot of the new Centralised Pension Payments System (CPPS) under the Employees' Pension Scheme (EPS) 1995. Conducted on October 29-30, the pilot disbursed approximately Rs 11 crore to over 49,000 EPS pensioners across Jammu, Srinagar, and Karnal.

The CPPS enables pensioners to receive payments from any bank branch nationwide, eliminating the need for regional transfers and streamlining disbursements. Expected to fully launch by January 2025 as part of EPFO's Centralised IT Enabled System (CITES 2.01), the CPPS will benefit over 78 lakh pensioners, enhancing the EPFO's modernization and efficiency in pension services.



Second Indian Military Heritage Festival commenced in New Delhi on November 8, 2024 09/11/2024

The second annual Indian Military
Heritage Festival (IMHF) commenced
in New Delhi on November 8, 2024. This
two-day event aims to engage global
and Indian think tanks, corporations,
public and private sector
organizations, non-profits,
academicians, and research scholars
focused on India's national security,
foreign policy, military history, and
heritage.

The festival was inaugurated by Chief of Defence Staff Gen. Anil Chauhan alongside three Service Chiefs. During the inauguration, Project 'Shaurya Gatha' was launched, an initiative by the Department of Military Affairs and the United Service Institution (USI) of India to conserve and promote India's military heritage through education and tourism.

On November 7, 2024, President Droupadi Murmu visited the Indian Navy's indigenous aircraft carrier, INS Vikrant, marking her first time aboard Navy vessels at sea. After arriving at INS Hansa in Goa, she was greeted by Chief of the Naval Staff Admiral Dinesh K Tripathi and Vice Admiral Sanjay J Singh, with a ceremonial Guard of Honour in her honor. Aboard INS Vikrant, the President observed a series of naval demonstrations, including deck-based fighter operations, missile drills, submarine maneuvers, and a flypast involving over 30 aircraft.



India reduces tuberculosis (TB)
cases with a 17.7% drop from
2015 to 2023
06/11/2024

India's progress in reducing tuberculosis (TB) has gained global recognition, with a 17.7% drop in TB cases from 2015 to 2023. This decline is more than twice the global average of 8.3%, according to the World Health Organization's Global Tuberculosis Report 2024.

India committed to achieving the United Nations' "End TB" targets by 2025, five years before the 2030 Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) deadline. This progress reflects the success of India's National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme, which has led to an 80% decrease in TB cases and a 90% reduction in TB deaths since 2015.



5th edition of Vietnam-India Bilateral Army Exercise from 4 to 23 November at Ambala 05/11/2024

The fifth Vietnam-India Bilateral Army Exercise (VINBAX) 2024 began on November 4, 2024, in Ambala, Haryana. The goal of VINBAX-2024 is to strengthen the joint military abilities of India and Vietnam.

This year's exercise is special because, for the first time, it includes personnel from both the Army and Air Force of each country. The Indian Army has sent 47 personnel, including a Regiment of the Corps of Engineers and members from other units.

VINBAX-2024 will end on November 23.

The 15th India-US joint Special Forces exercise, VAJRA PRAHAR, began on September 2, 2024, at Orchard Combat Training Centre in Idaho, USA, and will end on September 22. The previous VAJRA PRAHAR was held in December 2023 in Umroi, Meghalaya. This is the second India-US Army exercise of the year, following YUDH ABHYAS 2024, which took place in Rajasthan in September.

In VAJRA PRAHAR, each country's contingent includes 45 personnel: Special Forces units from India and Green Berets from the US. The goal is to improve military cooperation, focusing on interoperability, joint operations, and tactical skills in desert and semi-desert environments, with emphasis on physical fitness and joint planning.



Rajesh Kumar Singh, IAS became the Defence Secretary 02/11/2024

Rajesh Kumar Singh, an IAS officer from the 1989 Kerala cadre, became the Defence Secretary on November 1, 2024. He replaced Giridhar Aramane, a 1988 Andhra Pradesh cadre IAS officer, who retired the day before. Before starting his new role, Mr. Singh paid respects at the National War Memorial in New Delhi.

Previously, he was the Secretary of the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry. He has held various key roles in the Union Government and also served as Secretary for Urban Development and Finance in Kerala.

Ayodhya set two Guinness World Records on October 30, 2024, during Deepotsav. Over 2.5 million diyas were lit on the Saryu River banks, and the most people performed a simultaneous 'diya' rotation.

Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath received the Guinness certificates, joined by Union Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat and Deputy CM Brajesh Pathak.

JMM Leader Hemant Soren
Becomes Chief Minister of
Jharkhand for the Fourth Time
28/11/2024

Hemant Soren, the leader of the Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM), is set to take the oath as the Chief Minister of Jharkhand for the fourth time on 28 November 2024. This follows the recent state elections where his JMM-led coalition secured a decisive victory, winning 56 out of the 81 Assembly seats. The swearing-in ceremony will take place at 4 pm at the Morabadi Ground in Ranchi, with Governor Santosh Kumar Gangwar administering the oath.

Soren's victory marks a significant moment in Jharkhand's political history, as it is the first time an incumbent government has returned to power after completing a full five-year term. The JMM achieved its highest-ever tally, winning 34 of the 43 seats it contested, while its allies, the Congress and RJD, secured 16 and four seats respectively.

The ceremony is expected to be attended by several prominent leaders from the INDIA bloc, including Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge, Rahul Gandhi, and West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee. In his victory speech, Soren expressed gratitude to the people of Jharkhand for their continued trust and emphasized the importance of unity and social justice.



Winter session of Parliament commence on 25 November 2024

25/11/2024

The Winter session of Parliament will commence on 25 November 2024, featuring 19 sittings over 26 days. There will be no session on 26 November to

commemorate **Constitution Day**, with the main celebration at the Central Hall of Samvidhan Sadan.

The session will continue until 20
December 2024, with 16 bills listed for legislative business, including the Bhartiya Vayuyan Vidheyak, 2024, the Disaster Management (Amendment) Bill, 2024, the Railways (Amendment) Bill, the Waqf (Amendment) Bill, and the Indian Ports Bill, 2024. Additionally, discussions and voting on Supplementary Demands for Grants for 2024-25 will be addressed.

An all-party meeting was held to ensure smooth functioning, with Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju urging cooperation from opposition parties. 42 leaders from 30 political parties participated, providing suggestions to be discussed in the business advisory committee.

Congress MP Pramod

Tiwari highlighted issues for discussion, including an alleged bribery scam, the Manipur situation, unemployment, and pollution in North India. The meeting

was presided over by **Defence Minister Rajnath Singh**, with attendance from various Union Ministers and MPs.

Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla urged members to follow parliamentary decorum, inspired by the Constituent Assembly debates and discussions.

On November 1, eight states and five Union Territories celebrate their Foundation Day. These include Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, along with the UTs of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Delhi, Lakshadweep, and Puducherry. Prime Minister Narendra Modi extended his wishes, recognizing their contributions to the nation.

Andhra Pradesh was the first state created based on language, formed

on November 1, 1956, after the split of Hyderabad State.

Karnataka, previously called Mysore, was restructured on November 1, 1956, uniting Kannada-speaking regions. It celebrates "Rajyotsava Day" with parades and cultural programs.

Kerala was also formed on November 1, 1956, by merging Malabar, Cochin, and Travancore, celebrating its rich heritage and literacy achievements.

Madhya Pradesh, known as India's "heart," was reorganized on November 1, 1956, with celebrations including traditional performances and awards.

Chhattisgarh became India's 26th state on November 1, 2000, and is renowned as the "rice bowl of India."

Haryana was carved out from Punjab on November 1, 1966, due to linguistic distinctions, honoring its legacy in agriculture and sports.

Punjab was restructured on the same day in 1966 to establish a state for Punjabi speakers, highlighting its vibrant culture and history.

Shukrayaan Mission: ISRO's
Venus Orbiting Satellite
Scheduled for Launch in 2028
27/11/2024

ISRO has received approval from the Indian government for the **Shukrayaan** mission, a Venus Orbiting Satellite set to launch in **2028**. Announced by ISRO Director Nilesh Desai, the mission will enhance India's planetary exploration capabilities.


Desai also revealed plans for **Chandrayaan 4**, a collaborative mission with Japan, aiming for a precise landing at the Moon's south pole by **2030**, pending approval. This mission will feature a heavier rover weighing **350 kg**, significantly larger than Chandrayaan 3's.

ISRO is advancing its **INSAT 4 series** for improved weather forecasting and communication, incorporating advanced sensors and satellites to match global technological standards in meteorology and oceanography.

Future plans include a **Mars mission** with both orbital and surface exploration goals, and the **Gaganyaan** human spaceflight program, with an unmanned flight

expected in two years, followed by a manned mission.

The Indian government has also approved the construction of a **space station**, with the first module set for **2028** and full completion by **2035**. The space station will serve as a transit hub for future lunar missions, aligning with India's goal to land on the Moon by **2040**.



Scientists at JNCASR identify new pathway for Monkeypox detection and diagnostics 23/11/2024

Scientists at the Jawaharlal Nehru
Centre for Advanced Scientific
Research (JNCASR) have discovered a novel method to detect and develop diagnostic tools for the Monkeypox virus (MPV). They identified and characterized G-quadruplex sequences (GQs) within the MPV genome, which are unique nucleic acid structures absent in other pox viruses, pathogens, or the human genome.

This discovery holds potential for creating diagnostic tools and antiviral therapies, as these GQs can be targeted using small-molecule fluorescent probes. The Ministry of Science and Technology emphasized that this work is significant given the global concerns about MPV's

unanticipated spread, unclear transmission modes, and symptoms. The research offers valuable insights into MPV virology and aids in developing diagnostic and therapeutic interventions.



India Launches First Indigenous
Antibiotic, Nafithromycin, to
Combat Drug-Resistant
Infections
21/11/2024

On 20 November 2024, Union Minister of Science and Technology, Dr. Jitendra Singh,

launched **Nafithromycin**, India's first indigenous antibiotic, to combat drugresistant infections. Speaking at the launch event in New Delhi, he highlighted that the three-day treatment regimen of Nafithromycin is a breakthrough in addressing drugresistant pneumonia, a condition causing over two million deaths annually.

Developed with support from the Biotechnology Industry Research Assistance Council (BIRAC), under the Department of Biotechnology, the drug is marketed under the trade name **Miqnaf**. This Made-in-India antibiotic is a significant step in tackling Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR), marking a milestone in India's pharmaceutical innovation.



ISRO Launches GSAT-20 via SpaceX's Falcon 9 from Cape Canaveral, USA

19/11/2024

ISRO successfully launched its advanced communications satellite **GSAT-20** aboard SpaceX's **Falcon 9 rocket** from Cape Canaveral, USA, on **18 November 2024**. The satellite, weighing **4,700 kg**, is one of India's heaviest and will provide **broadband services in remote areas** and **in-flight Internet on passenger aircraft**.

First-time collaboration with SpaceX: ISRO launched GSAT-20 through its commercial arm, New Space India Limited (NSIL).

Reason for choosing SpaceX: India's LVM-3 rocket, or "Bahubali," cannot carry such a heavy payload, and French provider Arianespace lacks operational rockets currently. SpaceX's Falcon-9, capable of launching up to 8.3 tonnes to geostationary transfer orbit, was chosen.

Operational Lifespan: GSAT-20 will operate for **14 years**.

Satellite status: It is healthy, and its **solar panels have been deployed**.

This marks a significant milestone in ISRO's efforts to enhance satellite-based broadband connectivity.



World's first CO₂-to-methanol conversion plant at NTPC Vindhyachal 09/11/2024

On November 8, 2024, NTPC, India's largest power producer, marked its 50th anniversary by inaugurating the world's first CO₂-to-methanol conversion plant at its Vindhyachal facility. NTPC Chairman Gurdeep Singh called this a "historic step" in carbon management and sustainable fuel production.

The company is advancing various green technologies, including Gen-4 ethanol, green urea, and sustainable aviation fuel. Additionally, NTPC has developed the first indigenous catalyst for methanol synthesis and is progressing in hydrogen and carbon capture innovations. At the event, NTPC also introduced hydrogen-fueled buses in Leh and launched new IT applications.



World's first wooden satellite, LignoSat was launched into space by Japan 06/11/2024

On November 5, 2024, Japan launched LignoSat, the world's first wooden satellite, into space to test wood's viability as a space-grade material. Developed by Kyoto University researchers, LignoSat is made from honoki wood, traditionally used for sword sheaths.

After a 10-month experiment on the ISS, honoki was found to be the most suitable timber for space applications. Constructed using a traditional Japanese technique without screws or glue, LignoSat will orbit Earth for six months, testing wood's resilience to extreme temperatures (-100 to 100°C) and its potential to shield semiconductors from space radiation.



ISRO launch India's first analog space mission in Leh, Ladakh 04/11/2024

ISRO has launched India's first analog space mission in Leh, Ladakh, simulating life in an interplanetary habitat to advance India's lunar and interplanetary mission goals. Analog missions are conducted in Earth locations with conditions that mimic space environments, helping to test and solve challenges for space research. Ladakh's dry, cold climate and high-altitude terrain resemble Martian and lunar landscapes, making it ideal for such a mission.

The month-long mission includes a compact, inflatable habitat named Hab-1, equipped with a hydroponics farm, kitchen, and sanitation, creating a self-sustaining environment. This setup offers insights into sustaining human life for long-term space missions to the Moon and Mars. Collaboratively organized by ISRO's Human Spaceflight Centre, AAKA Space Studio, University of Ladakh, IIT Bombay, and the Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council, the mission also leverages Ladakh's low-oxygen, low-pressure conditions to evaluate life support systems, essential for future interplanetary missions.

Jay Shah became the Chairman of the International Cricket Council (ICC) on December 1, 2024, marking him as the fifth Indian to head the global cricket body. Shah, was unanimously elected by the ICC Board of Directors, succeeding New Zealand's Greg Barclay. 36-year-old Jay Shah, has been the secretary of Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) for the last five years

In his inaugural statement, Shah highlighted his vision to use cricket's inclusion in the Los Angeles 2028 Olympics as a transformative opportunity and emphasized the growth of women's cricket as a key priority.

At the Syed Modi International Tournament 2024 in Lucknow, PV Sindhu and Lakshya Sen emerged as Singles champions. Sindhu, a two-time Olympic medallist, won the Women's Singles title by defeating China's Wu Luo Yu 21-14, 21-16. Lakshya Sen claimed the Men's Singles title with a commanding victory over Singapore's Jia Heng Jason Teh 21-6, 21-7.

In Women's Doubles, the Indian duo Treesa Jolly and Gayatri Gopichand won the title, beating China's Bao Li Jing and Li Qian 21-18, 21-11. However, Indian teams in Men's Doubles and Mixed Doubles finished as runner-ups. Pruthvi Krishnamurthy Roy and Sai Pratheek K lost a close Men's Doubles final to China's Huang Di and Liu Yang (14-21, 21-19, 17-21), while Dhruv Kapila and Tanisha Crasto were defeated by Thailand's Dechapol Puavaranukroh and Supissara Paewsampran (21-18, 14-21, 8-21) in the Mixed Doubles final.



World Chess Championship: Gukesh and Liren Tie in 4th Game

The fourth game of the FIDE Chess World Championship between D. Gukesh and defending champion Ding Liren ended in a draw on 29 November 2024 in Singapore, leaving both players with 2 points each. Gukesh had leveled the score in Game 3 by defeating Liren.

Best video game consoles

The championship consists of 14 games, with the first player to reach 7.5 points being crowned champion.

This historic tournament, featuring two Asian players for the first time in 138 years, has a prize pool of \$2.5 million. A win earns 1 point, a draw 0.5 points, and a loss 0 points.



Vaibhav Suryavanshi, 13, Becomes Youngest Cricket Player to Secure IPL Contract 27/11/2024

Vaibhav Suryavanshi, at just 13 years old, made history as the youngest cricket player to secure an IPL contract during the IPL 2025 Auction. He was signed by the Rajasthan Royals, led by Rahul Dravid, for ₹1.10 crore. Bihar Cricket Association President Rakesh Tiwari praised Vaibhav's achievement and expressed confidence in his potential.

Vaibhav gained attention by becoming the youngest batter to score an international century, hitting a 104 off 62 balls in a Youth Test for India Under-19 against Australia Under-19 in Chennai. His 58-ball century was the fastest by an Indian in Youth Tests and the second-fastest globally. Earlier this year, Vaibhav debuted in the Ranji Trophy for Bihar at the age of 12, becoming the youngest player in India's premier First-Class tournament.



Divith Reddy won the gold medal at the Under-8 World Cadets Chess Championship 27/11/2024

Eight-year-old Divith Reddy from Telangana won the **gold medal** at the **Under-8 World Cadets Chess Championship** in Montesilvano, Italy, on **26 November 2024**.

Divith scored **9 points out of 11**, tying with fellow Indian **Sattwik Swain** but securing gold due to a superior tiebreak score. Sattwik earned the silver medal, while **Ziming Guo** of China claimed bronze.

With a **FIDE rating of 1784**, Divith started strong with four consecutive wins, faced setbacks with two losses, but made a remarkable comeback by winning the final five rounds to clinch the title.



India advanced to the final of the Women's Asian Hockey Champions Trophy 2024 by defeating Japan 2-0 in the semi-final held on 19 November 2024 at Rajgir Hockey Stadium, Bihar. India entered the semifinals as favorites, having won all their group-stage matches, including a 3-0 victory over Japan.

China also secured a spot in the final by beating Malaysia 3-1 in the other semi-final, marking their fifth win in six games. Malaysia, with 2 wins and 4 losses, will now compete against Japan for the bronze medal.

The final match between India and China will take place on 20 November 2024, at 4:45 PM, while the bronze medal match between Malaysia and Japan is scheduled for 2:15 PM on the same day at Rajgir Hockey Stadium.



Magnus Carlsen wins Tata Steel Chess India Blitz event 18/11/2024

At the Tata Steel Chess India tournament in Kolkata, Magnus Carlsen, World No. 1, secured the blitz title on November 17, 2024. Carlsen staged a crucial comeback against India's Arjun Erigaisi in the penultimate round, ensuring an unassailable lead with 12 points. He concluded the tournament by defeating Vidit

Gujrathi, achieving 13 points and clinching the blitz crown. This marks Carlsen's second double victory in Kolkata, having achieved the same in 2019.

Indian players also performed well: Arjun Erigaisi finished third with 10.5 points, R Praggnanandhaa placed fourth with 9.5, and Vidit Gujrathi secured fifth with 9 points.



Pankaj Advani won the 2024 World Billiards Championship 13/11/2024

Veteran Indian billiards player Pankaj Advani won the 2024 World Billiards Championship, achieving his 28th world title and his seventh consecutive win. The championship, held by the International Billiards and Snooker Federation (IBSF) in Doha, Qatar, saw Advani, 39, defeat England's Robert Hall in a thrilling 4-2 final match on November 9, 2024. Advani's career also includes two Asian Games gold medals, won in 2006 and 2010.



GM Aravindh Chithambaram wins Chennai Grand Masters Chess Tournament 2024 12/11/2024

In the Chennai Grand Masters Chess Tournament on November 11, 2024, GM Aravindh Chithambaram won the Masters title after a challenging final against American GM Levon Aronian. Aravindh secured victory by winning the first blitz play-off and drawing the second match with the black pieces.

Meanwhile, GM V Pranav remained unbeaten to win the Challengers title. The tournament, organized by MGD1 and sponsored by the Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu, included two categories: Masters and Challengers.

Indian boxer Mandeep Jangra won the World Boxing Federation's (WBF) Super Featherweight world title in the Cayman Islands, defeating Britain's Conor McIntosh with a unanimous 10-0 decision on November 5, 2024. First Banana Export Train from Andhra's Tadipatri

23/11/2024

The South Central Railway (SCR), in collaboration with the Container Corporation of India (CONCOR), launched the first Banana Export Train of the season on November 22, 2024 from Tadipatri, Andhra Pradesh. This initiative marks a significant milestone in India's agricultural export sector.

The train, carrying a load of **980 metric** tonnes of locally grown bananas, is headed to the Jawaharlal Nehru Port in Mumbai, from where the consignment will be exported to international markets. This move is expected to save both time and fuel, as transporting such a large consignment by road would have required around 150 trucks.

The bananas are being exported under the brand name "Happy Bananas", and the initiative aims to enhance the productivity, quality of produce, post-harvest treatment, and packing. Farmers from the Putlur region in Anantapur and Pulivendula in Kadapa district are exporting Green Cavendish bananas to many international markets.

This development is part of a broader effort to boost fruit exports from Andhra Pradesh, with the government targeting exports of **30,000 metric** tonnes of fruits from the state. The collaboration with six major corporate companies aims to provide market linkage and ensure higher prices for local farmers.



Meluri becomes 17th district of Nagaland 05/11/2024

Meluri, home to the Pochury Naga tribe, has been officially declared the 17th district of Nagaland. The state government announced that Meluri, previously a sub-division of Phek District, is now a full district.
