Azerbaijan Airline Crash in Kazakhstan

On December 25, 2024, an Azerbaijan Airlines flight, **J2-8243**, crashed near Aktau, Kazakhstan, resulting in the tragic loss of **38 lives** and leaving **29 survivors**. The Embraer 190 aircraft was en route from Baku, Azerbaijan, to Grozny, Russia, when it encountered severe turbulence and loud bangs, leading to a catastrophic crash.


Key Details:

Flight Path: The plane was diverted from its original route due to heavy fog in Grozny and attempted an emergency landing in Aktau.

Survivor Accounts: Passengers reported hearing multiple loud bangs and experiencing a loss of cabin pressure before the crash.

Investigation: Authorities from Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, and Russia have launched investigations to determine the cause of the crash. Initial speculations suggest possible **external interference**, with some sources indicating that Russian air defenses might have mistakenly shot down the aircraft.

Casualties: The crash claimed 38 lives, including both pilots, and left many survivors with serious injuries.

<u>China Approves World's Largest Dam on</u> the Brahmaputra River

China has recently approved the construction of the world's largest dam on the Brahmaputra River, located in Tibet near the Indian border. This ambitious project, estimated to cost around \$137 billion, has raised significant concerns in India and Bangladesh.

Key Details:

Location: The dam will be built at a significant gorge in the Himalayan reaches where the Brahmaputra River makes a U-turn before flowing into Arunachal Pradesh and subsequently into Bangladesh.

Scale: The project is expected to exceed one trillion yuan (\$137 billion), surpassing even China's Three Gorges Dam, currently the world's largest.

Purpose: The primary aim is to develop clean energy and respond to climate change and extreme hydrological disasters. The hydropower facility is estimated to generate over 300 billion kWh of electricity annually, enough to supply energy to approximately 300 million people for a year.

Concerns: India and Bangladesh have expressed apprehensions about potential impacts on water flow and regional stability. There are fears that China could control the

water flow and release large amounts of water during conflicts.

Safety Measures: China has assured that extensive geological studies and advanced technology have been employed to ensure the project's safety and minimize ecological impact. The dam will also incorporate measures for disaster prevention and relief.

International Reactions:

India's Response: India has raised concerns about the potential impact on water flow and the ability of China to control water during hostilities. India is also constructing its own dam on the Brahmaputra in Arunachal Pradesh.

China's Assurance: Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Mao Ning has stated that the project will not negatively affect the lower reaches and that China will continue to maintain communication with countries at the lower reaches through existing channels.

Torch Rally for the 38th National Games in Uttarakhand

Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami inaugurated the torch procession of the 38th National Games from Haldwani in Nainital district on December 26, 2024.

Route and Duration: The torch will travel through 99 locations across 13 districts over 33 days, covering a distance of 3,823 kilometers.

Culmination: The relay will conclude in Dehradun on January 25, 2025, just before the National Games' inauguration on January 28.

Purpose: The rally aims to raise awareness about the National Games and engage the public in sports activities.

Significance: Hosting the National Games is seen as a historic opportunity for Uttarakhand to foster a sports culture and contribute to the state's development.

About the National Games

History: The National Games are a multi-sport event held in India, showcasing the country's athletic talent.

Frequency: Held every four years, the event brings together athletes from across the nation to compete in various sports.

Purpose: The Games aim to promote sportsmanship, unity, and excellence in sports among Indian athletes.

Inclusion of Traditional Sports: For the first time, yoga and mallakhamb will be included as demonstration sports in the National Games.

Infrastructure Development: Significant investments have been made in sports infrastructure, including new playgrounds, upgraded stadiums, and facilities for various sports.

Former Prime Minister Dr Manmohan Singh passes away at 92

Former Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh passed away on **26 December 2024** at the age of **92** in New Delhi. He had been in poor health for the last few months and was admitted to AIIMS in critical condition. He is survived by his wife **Gursharan Kaur** and three daughters.

Prime Minister: He served as India's **13th Prime Minister** from **2004 to 2014** in the Congress-led UPA government.

Finance Minister: Appointed Finance Minister in **1991**, introduced reforms like rupee devaluation, tax restructuring, and removal of trade barriers.

RBI Governor: Served as the Governor of the Reserve Bank of India from **September 1982 to January 1985**.

Economic Reforms: Dr. Singh is considered the architect of the **1991 economic reforms** that ushered in economic liberalisation in India.

Early Life: Born on **26 September 1932** in Gah, Punjab (now in Pakistan), he pursued economics at Punjab University, Cambridge University, and Oxford University.

Parliamentary Career: Elected to the Rajya Sabha from Assam in **1991**, served as Leader of the Opposition from **1998 to 2004**, and became the first Sikh Prime Minister of India in **2004**.

Awards: Honored with several awards, including the Padma Vibhushan in 1987 and the Euro Money Award for Finance Minister in 1993.

PM Modi Lays Foundation for Ken-Betwa River Linking Project in Madhya Pradesh

Foundation Stone Laid: Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of the Ken-Betwa National River Linking Project on 25 December 2024 in Khajuraho, Madhya Pradesh.

Inaugurations: Modi also inaugurated the Omkareshwar Floating Solar Project and performed Bhoomi Pujan of 1,153 Atal Gram Sushasan Bhawans.

Commemorations: A stamp and coin were released in memory of former Prime Minister **Atal Bihari Vajpayee** on his 100th birth anniversary.

Project Cost and Funding: The Ken-Betwa project costs **Rs 44,605 crores**, with 90% funded by the Central Government and 10% by State Governments.

Benefits:

Irrigation: Facilities for more than 8 lakh hectares in Madhya Pradesh and 2.51 lakh hectares in Uttar Pradesh.

Drinking Water: Facilities for 44 lakh people in Madhya Pradesh and 21 lakh people in Uttar Pradesh.

General (Dr.) Vijay Kumar Singh (Retd.): Designated as the new Governor of **Mizoram**.



Kristrun Frostadottir Becomes Iceland's Youngest Prime Minister

ICC Champions Trophy 2025: India's Matches to be Held in UAE, Confirms PCB

The Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) has designated the **United Arab Emirates (UAE)** as the neutral venue for India's matches in the 2025 ICC Champions Trophy.

Reason: This decision follows India's refusal to travel to Pakistan due to security concerns.

Confirmation: The International Cricket Council (ICC) confirmed on December 19 that all India's matches, including potential semifinals and the final, will be played at a neutral venue under a hybrid hosting model.

Likely Location: While the PCB did not specify the exact location, **Dubai** is widely expected to host the matches.

Group Stage: India has three group-stage games, including a highly anticipated clash with Pakistan.

Further Matches: Should India advance, the UAE will also host one of the semifinals and the final.

Resolution: The decision resolves a standoff between the two cricketing rivals and clears the way for the ICC to announce the schedule for the eight-team, 50-over tournament.

Historical Context: India and Pakistan have not toured each other's countries since 2012 due to ongoing political tensions, with their cricketing interactions limited to neutral venues and ICC events.

Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, **Bhupender Yadav**, released

the India State of Forest Report 2023 (ISFR 2023) on 21st December 2024 at the Forest Research Institute in Dehradun.

Total Forest and Tree Cover: The total forest and tree cover in India is **827,357 square kilometers**, representing **25.17%** of the country's geographical area.

Forest Cover: 715,343 square kilometers

Tree Cover: 112,014 square kilometers

Growth in Cover: The forest and tree cover has increased by 1,445 square kilometers since the 2021 assessment, with 156 square kilometers added to forest cover and 1,289 square kilometers to tree cover.

Technology in Forest Management: The Forest Survey of India (FSI) uses **advanced technology** for **real-time fire alerts** and forest fire services to improve forest management.

Assessment Method: The report is published biennially, using satellite data and field-based surveys for a comprehensive assessment of forest and tree resources in India.

Madan Lokur Appointed as Chairperson of the United Nations Internal Justice Council (IJC)

Appointment: Former Supreme Court judge Madan B. Lokur has been appointed as the Chairperson of the United Nations Internal Justice Council (IJC). **Tenure**: His term will last 4 years, ending on **12th November 2028**.

UN Secretary-General's Communication: UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres expressed pleasure in appointing Justice Lokur, effective immediately.

Purpose of IJC: The IJC was established by the UN General Assembly to ensure **independence**, **professionalism**, **and accountability** in the administration of the UN's justice system.

Justice Lokur's Background: He retired as a Supreme Court judge on **31st December 2018**, after serving for more than 6 years.
