SVAMITVA Scheme: PM Modi Distributes 65 Lakh Property Cards

On January 18, 2025, Prime Minister Narendra Modi distributed over 65 lakh property cards under the SVAMITVA Scheme to beneficiaries across 50,000 villages in 10 states and 2 Union Territories, marking a significant milestone in rural empowerment and governance in India.

Objective: The scheme aimed to empower rural India by providing **Record of Rights** to property owners in **village Abadi areas** through drone technology for accurate surveying.

Benefits:

Economic transformation of rural India.

Monetization of property.

Access to institutional credit (bank loans).

Reduction in property disputes.

Better property assessments and tax collection.

Drone Surveys: Completed in over 3.17 lakh villages, covering 92% of the targeted areas. Over 2.25 crore property cards had been prepared for more than 1.5 lakh villages. **Full Saturation**: The scheme had reached full saturation in **Puducherry**, **Andaman and Nicobar Islands**, **Tripura**, **Goa**, **Uttarakhand**, and **Haryana**.

The SVAMITVA scheme, launched in **2020**, contributed to the **economic development** of rural areas by enabling better governance and access to resources.

Pixxel Space Launches World's Highest-Resolution Hyperspectral Satellites

Pixxel Space, a Bengaluru-based startup
backed by Google, launched its first private
satellite constellation, Firefly, on January 14,
2025, using a SpaceX rocket from California.

Key Features: Firefly consists of six satellites, making it the world's highest-resolution commercial hyperspectral imaging constellation. The satellites observe Earth in over 150 spectral bands, capturing detailed data for various applications.

Applications:

Agriculture: Monitoring vegetation health.

Mining: Identifying mineral compositions.

Environmental Monitoring: Tracking water quality and atmospheric changes.

Defense: Enhancing surveillance capabilities.

Future Plans: Three additional satellites to be launched in the next two months and Expansion to a 24-satellite constellation by 2029.

The technology enables precise detection of chemical, biological, and environmental changes, marking a major advancement in hyperspectral imaging.

Future Applications: The success of SpaDeX will support ambitious projects like the Indian Space Station and Chandrayaan-4. It showcased critical technologies for in-space robotics, spacecraft control, and payload operations.

Leadership and Indigenous Technology: The project was led by N. Surendran and featured the fully indigenous Bharatiya Docking System.

Launch Details: SpaDeX was launched on 30 December 2024 aboard the PSLV-C60

rocket along with other payloads.

Registration Process:

Applicants must register online on **ftittp.mha.gov.in**, fill in their details, and upload required documents. Biometric data will be captured at the **Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO)** or while passing through the airport.

Registered travellers will scan their airline boarding pass and passport at e-gates. Biometrics will be authenticated at both arrival and departure points, and upon successful authentication, the e-gate will open, granting immigration clearance.

Expansion Plan: FTI-TTP will be implemented at **21 major airports** across India.

Programme Launch: The programme was initially launched by Amit Shah in June 2024 at Terminal-3 of Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI), New Delhi.

India Women's Cricket Team Sets Records with 304-Run Victory Over Ireland in Rajkot

Richa Ghosh added a quick 59 runs off 42 balls.

Ireland's Response: Ireland was bowled out for 131 runs in 31.4 overs.



<u>US Removes Sanctions on Major Indian</u> <u>Nuclear Facilities</u>

Sanctions lifted on Indian entities: The US has removed sanctions on three Indian entities— Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), Indian Rare Earths Ltd (IREL), and Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research (IGCAR).

Reason for lifting sanctions: The sanctions, imposed during the Cold War era, were lifted to enhance US foreign policy goals, support shared energy security needs, and strengthen joint efforts in science and technology between India and the US.

Strengthened India-US collaboration: Recent years have seen increased cooperation in peaceful nuclear activities and related research, benefiting global partner countries.

US action against Chinese companies: The US added 11 Chinese companies to the Entity List for activities deemed contrary to US national security and foreign policy interests.

About the Entity List: It is a US government compilation of foreign individuals, companies, and organizations considered a national security concern.

Ira Jadhav Shatters Records with Unbeaten 346 in Women's Under 19 One Day Trophy On January 13, 2024, Ira Jadhav from Mumbai became the highest individual scorer in Women's Under 19 One Day Trophy history. The 14-year-old prodigy played an unbeaten inning of 346 runs off 157 balls against Meghalaya at the Alur Cricket Stadium in Bengaluru.

Her extraordinary performance, which included **42 fours and 16 sixes**, led Mumbai to a monumental total of 563 for 3 in 50 overs. Ira's achievement surpassed the **previous record held by Smriti Mandhana**, who scored 224 runs off 150 deliveries in 2013 while playing for Maharashtra. This remarkable feat has set a new benchmark in women's domestic cricket and highlighted Ira's immense potential as a future star.

Committee Objective: The UN Committee investigates the benefits and challenges of big data, including its use in monitoring and reporting on sustainable development goals (SDGs).




